Our Location

Cedar Farm is located in the rural village of Mawdesley. Cedar Farm is not on a direct bus route, although buses do run through Mawdesley village centre which is approximately half a mile walk away.

Parking

Disabled parking is available and is located on the left of the main entrance with clearly marked signs.

Alternatively there are parking spaces right next to the Pig Barn building where the Courses Room is located.

General Access Information

Cedar Farm is predominantly on one level and all the shops, studios and food venues are accessible by wheelchair. There is a small step by The Potting Sheds and The Gallery, but there are alternative entrances to these shops that are on one level.

Because we are located on a farm the pathways can sometimes be a little uneven so extra care will need to be taken.

The Courses Room is located at ground level in the Pig Barn building and can be accessed via double doors.

Flooring throughout the building is smooth wooden flooring.

The Courses Room is well lit with natural and electric lights.

There are accessible toilets located just in the art@cedarfarm building which is opposite the Pig Barn.
